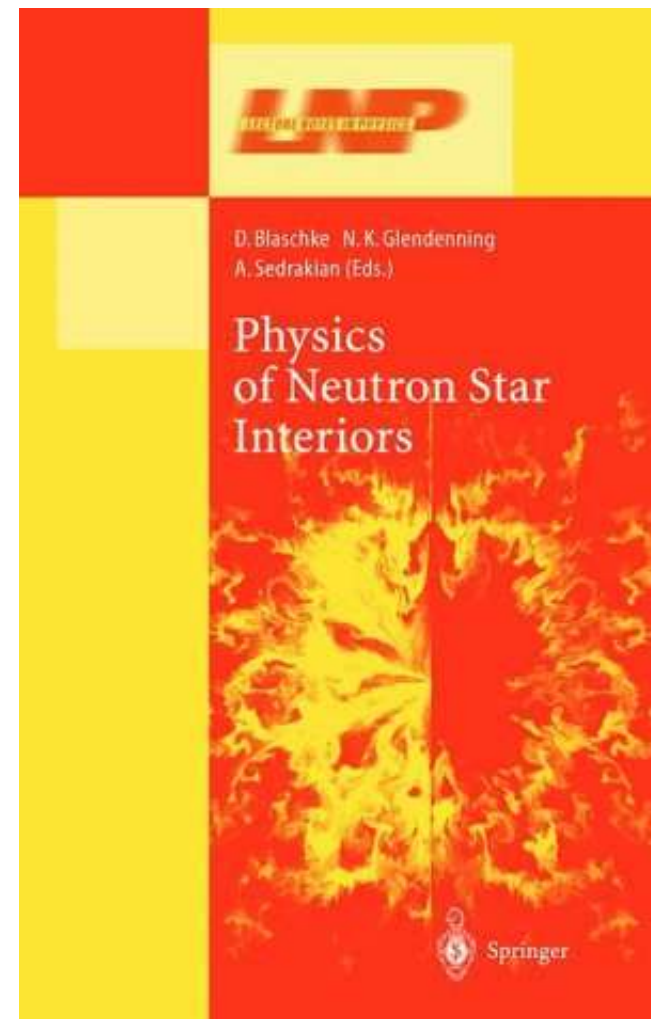

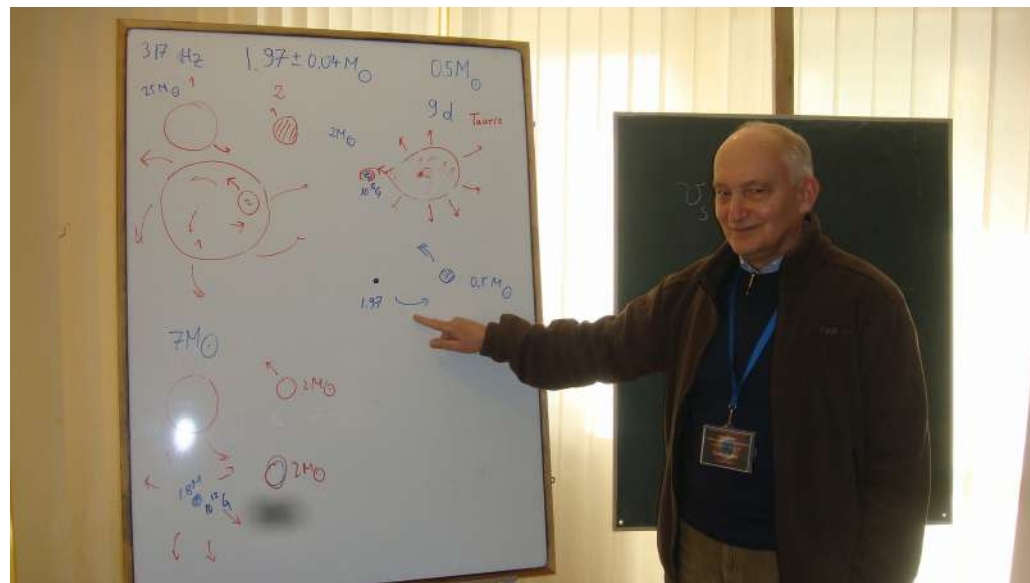

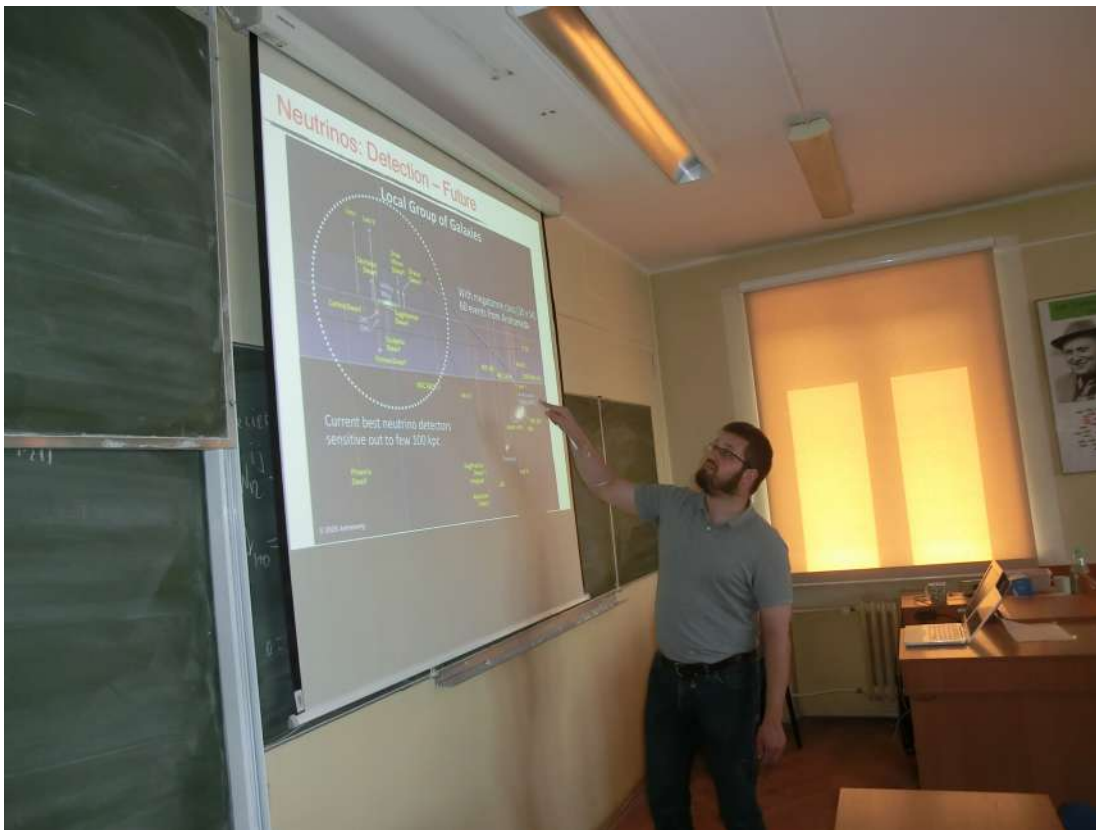

## Conference Warsaw, March 2017



Historical background - crucial date

- 1789 - the French Revolution
- 1795 - final partition of Poland - Warsaw is in the Russian sector
- 1807-1812 - capital of the Warsaw Duchy
- 1815-1830 - Warsaw is the capital the Polish Congress Kingdom (parliamentary monarchy within the Russian Empire)
- 1830 - November Uprising - war against Russia. Loss of autonomy. Repressions. Emigration.
- 1863 - January Uprising against Russia. Repressions. Strong russification starts.
- 1905-6 - some liberalization starts
- 1918 - Polish state reestablished
- 1939-1945 - Warsaw occupied by Germans. 90% of the central Warsaw destroyed during and after Warsaw Uprising
